

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2023 Accomplishments

- Family Partner inclusion in planning, implementing, and **leading** Family-Centered Care efforts with healthcare professionals.
- Healthcare Partners and Family Partners on Executive Council are **diverse** in their perspectives.
- Provided **six free educational webinars** featuring FCC work by healthcare partners, researchers, and family partners. These have received robust attendance live and are widely shared and viewed.
- Successfully mentored small group model with five cohorts that meet bi-monthly to discuss barriers and successes in overcoming them.



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2023 Impact

- **Increase** in the percentage of centers that have FCC Committees **from 20% to 32%**.
- **Increase** in the percentage of centers that have Family Partnership Councils **from 16% to 20%**.

2023 Outreach

- More than doubled listserv membership - **700+!!!**
- Partnered with several esteemed national organizations representing multidisciplinary groups.
- Website, YouTube Channel, and Twitter account continually show improved engagement and are updated many times each month.
- Six free educational webinars scheduled for 2024.
